Directions to VISARTS:

Notice: Gibbs Street, where VisArts is located, is a new street and will not appear on most GPS systems.

From the North: Take I-270 South towards Washington. Take Exit 6/W. Montgomery Ave., bear left towards Rockville/Rockville Town Center. Continue on W. Montgomery Ave. (MD 28E), Turn left on N. Washington St. Turn Right on E. Middle Lane, turn left on Gibbs St. VisArts is on your right, sharing the block with the library.

From the South: Take I-495 N., take slight left at I-270 N. spur towards Rockville/Fredrick. Merge onto I-270 N. (Fredrick) and take exit 6A/W. Montgomery Ave. Bear right on W. Montgomery Ave. (MD 28E). Turn left on S. Washington St., Turn right on E. Middle Lane, turn left on Gibbs St. VisArts is on your right, sharing the block with the library.

From the Metro: VisArts is a 5 minute walk from the Rockville Metro stop on the Red Line. Exit the Metro and follow signs pointing

to “Rockville Town Center”. Walk towards 355 N. and Cross over at the corner onto E. Middle Lane. Walk two blocks and make a right onto Gibbs St.

Parking for VISARTS: Free garage parking is available for VisArts patrons beginning at 7 p.m. on weeknights at the following Rockville Town Square parking garages: 215 N. Washington St.; Rt. 355 garage; 30 Maryland Ave.
